

## Explore Waterfalls of Jharkhand- Ranchi – Betla – Netarhat

6 Days – 14th August



**Day 1:** 14th August – Train from Howrah - KRIYA YOGA EXP (18615)- 21:10 PM

**Day 2:** 15th August: Arrival at Ranchi(05:40) – Full Day Ranchi Sightseeing

Pickup: Early morning at 5:40 AM from Ranchi Railway Station. Meet your driver and freshen up at a pre-arranged place or hotel.

### Sightseeing:

- Dassam Falls – A beautiful cascade about 40 km from Ranchi, ideal for morning freshness.
- Jonha Falls – Also known as Gautamdhara, a serene waterfall with stairs leading down to the stream.
- Hundru Falls – One of the tallest waterfalls in Jharkhand, surrounded by dense forest and rocks.
- Tagore Hill – A peaceful hilltop offering panoramic views of Ranchi, linked to Rabindranath Tagore.
- Ranchi War Cemetery – A quiet and historically rich site maintained by the Commonwealth War Graves Commission.
- Rock Garden & Kanke Dam – End the day with a relaxed evening by the lake and rock structures. Overnight Stay: Hotel in Ranchi

**Day 3:** 16th August: Ranchi – Patratu Valley – Transfer to Netarhat (approx. 160 km)

Morning: After breakfast, drive towards **Patratu Valley** – enjoy the curvy scenic route with lush hills, waterfalls, and **Patratu Dam viewpoint**. Lunch: Enroute (can be arranged at a local dhaba).

Continue to **Netarhat, the “Queen of Chotanagpur”** – a charming hill station with pine forests and a cool climate.

### On the way sightseeing:

- Suga Bandh Waterfall (seasonal)
- Lodh Falls Viewpoint (if time permits)

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Evening: Catch the breathtaking Sunset at **Netarhat Sunset Point** – one of the most iconic views in Jharkhand. Overnight Stay: Hotel in Netarhat

**Day 4:** 17th August: Netarhat Local & Transfer to Betla via Enroute Attractions (Approx. 100 km). Morning: Visit key attractions in and around Netarhat:

- Netarhat Dam – Surrounded by thick forest and perfect for a calm start to the day.
- Upper Ghaghri Falls – A hidden gem within the sal forest.
- Lower Ghaghri Falls – Scenic waterfall, slightly off-road but worth a short trek.

Post-lunch: Depart for Betla, located in the heart of Palamu Tiger Reserve. Evening: Check-in to the hotel at Betla and relax amid nature. Optional: Night safari(extra cost) or walk near buffer zones if permitted. Overnight Stay: Betla

**Day 5:** 18th August: Betla Safari – Local Sightseeing – Ranchi Station Drop

Early Morning: Jeep safari (Extra cost) inside Betla National Park – one of the oldest tiger reserves in India. Spot deer, elephants, monkeys, and if lucky, leopards or tigers.

Post Safari Breakfast.

#### **Sightseeing:**

- Palamu Fort – Ruins of a 17th-century fort inside the forest, offering a mix of history and wilderness.
- Museum / Tribal Culture Center (if open)
- Afternoon: Lunch and drive back to Ranchi.

Evening: Drop at Ranchi Railway Station by 9:00 PM (train departs at 10:00 PM).
