Start Date: 5th June 2026 from Howrah Station

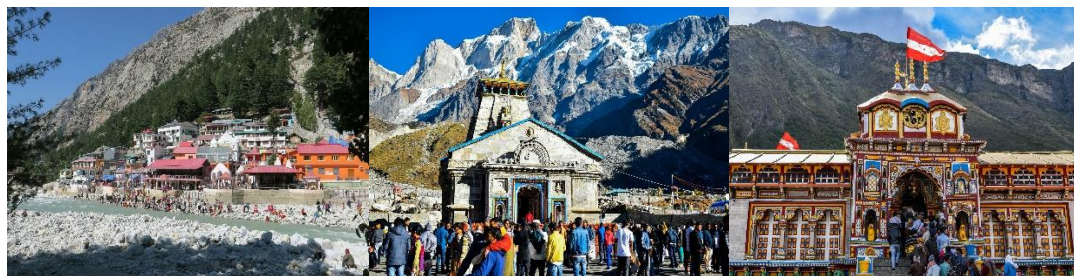

Day-wise Itinerary

Day 1 – 5th June | Howrah to Haridwar

Day 2 – 6th June | Arrival in Haridwar

Reaching Haridwar in the evening, we transfer to our hotel for check-in. In the evening, you may witness the enchanting Ganga Aarti at Har Ki Pauri, a divine spectacle of lamps, chants, and the flowing Ganga. Overnight stay in Haridwar.

Day 3 – 7th June | Haridwar to Jankichatti

After breakfast, we drive to the serene village of Jankichatti, the base for Yamunotri



Darshan. Nestled amid hills, it offers the perfect atmosphere to prepare for the pilgrimage ahead. Overnight stay in Jankichatti.

Day 4 – 8th June | Yamunotri Darshan

An early start takes us on a 6 km trek to the Yamunotri Temple. Along the route, waterfalls, forests, and mountain views accompany our steps. After offering prayers and bathing in the sacred hot spring of Surya Kund, we return to Jankichatti. Overnight stay at Jankichatti.

Day 5 – 9th June | Jankichatti to Uttarkashi

We continue our journey to Uttarkashi, a holy town on the banks of the Bhagirathi River, known for its temples and spiritual atmosphere. The evening is free for local temple visits. Overnight stay in Uttarkashi.

Day 6 – 10th June | Gangotri Excursion

A scenic drive through pine forests and valleys takes us to Gangotri, the origin point of the River Ganga. After darshan at the temple and moments of peace by the holy river, we return to Uttarkashi. Overnight stay in Uttarkashi.

Day 7 – 11th June | Uttarkashi to Guptkashi

Post breakfast, we travel to Guptkashi, a beautiful Himalayan town and the starting point for Kedarnath pilgrims. The day is for rest and preparation. Overnight stay in Guptkashi.

Day 8 – 12th June | Kedarnath Darshan

Today, we travel to Sonprayag and begin the uphill trek to Kedarnath, one of the twelve Jyotirlingas of Lord Shiva. The journey is filled with devotion, chants, and majestic Himalayan vistas. Upon arrival, we check into a dharamshala near the temple. Evening darshan and overnight stay at Kedarnath.

Day 9 – 13th June | Return from Kedarnath

After morning prayers at Kedarnath, we descend to Sonprayag and continue by road to Sitapur. Overnight stay at Sitapur.

Day 10 – 14th June | Sitapur to Badrinath

We begin our journey to Badrinath, passing through some of the most scenic Himalayan routes. Overnight stay at Badrinath.

Day 11 – 15th June | Badrinath Darshan & Mana Village

In the morning, we visit the Badrinath Temple for darshan. Later, explore Mana Village, the last village before the Indo-Tibet border, rich in mythological history and Himalayan traditions. Overnight stay in Badrinath.



Day 12 – 16th June | Badrinath to Srinagar (Garhwal)

After breakfast, we descend to Srinagar, a charming town in the Garhwal region. The evening is free to relax. Overnight stay in Srinagar.

Day 13 – 17th June | Srinagar to Haridwar

We make our way back to Haridwar. The evening can be spent shopping for souvenirs or taking a peaceful riverside walk. Overnight stay in Haridwar.

Day 14 – 18th June | Haridwar to Howrah

Morning transfer to Haridwar Railway Station for our train back to Howrah.

Day 15 – 19th June | Onboard Train

A full day of travel as we return through the heart of India, cherishing the memories of our spiritual adventure.

Day 16 – 20th June | Arrival at Howrah

We reach Howrah, bringing our sacred journey to a close, hearts filled with blessings and peace from the Himalayas.

Please see our Booking Terms and condition before booking confirmation.

- For Any Fixed Departure tour, a Minimum of 20 Heads is required.
- Below 20 heads, Only customized Packages are available.
- Seats are normally reserved on payment of 50% of total amount.
- Full and final payment is to be made before 30 days from the date of journey. If it is not paid before at least 15 days from the date of journey a compensation of Rs.100/- per head per day will be charged till not paid as a late fine.
- Bus / Car seats will be reserved on the first cum first served basis.
- No Choice of Seat will be accepted. The parties are requested to check their original tickets before the journey to avoid inconvenience during journey. The company (mercury tour operator/MTO) will not be liable for any dispute during journey.
- Please Book your Package at least 130 days before from the date of journey.



- Company(mto) will not be liable for any Kind of Bandh, Political disturbance, Natural Calamity during the tour . Due to this reason if the duration of tour is extended(as per the tour schedule)the extra cost has to be borne by the party.
- Manager or any company person will not undertake any liability towards any loss, damage of Life /Property, Any breakage of any belongings whatsoever of the tourist caused by any accident/theft/ robbery or any other towards happening during the tour.

- Full and Final Payment should be done in our Head Office only. No one from our office will collect the full and final payment from any customer from their residence /office.
