Step into the enchanting world of the **Sundarban Tiger Reserve**, home to the iconic Royal Bengal Tiger and the largest mangrove forest on Earth. Recognized as a **UNESCO World Heritage Site** (1985) and later declared a **Biosphere Reserve** (1989), this magical landscape continues to fascinate nature lovers, photographers, and adventure seekers from around the globe.

Date & Duration

• **Duration:** 2 Nights / 3 Days

Sundarban Tour Package from Kolkata – Detailed 3-Day Itinerary

Day 1: Kolkata → **Sundarbans**



Your journey begins early with reporting at EM Bypass by **8:00 AM** and departure at **8:30 AM**. Enjoy a hearty breakfast en route, followed by a short tea break before arriving at **Gadkhali Jetty**—the main gateway to the Sundarbans.

Board your boat and drift through calm rivers like **Gomor, Durgadhwani, and Pitchkhali**, surrounded by dense mangrove forests. On arrival at the resort, check in and enjoy a hot lunch. Later, visit **Sunset Point** for a spectacular evening view over the mangroves.

Return to the resort for tea and snacks, followed by a cultural evening featuring **Adivasi Jhumur Dance or Baul music**. Dinner will be served at **9 PM**.

Day 2: Full-Day Sundarban Jungle Safari

Start with breakfast at **7:00 AM** and leave for the jetty by **8:00 AM** for your full-day jungle safari.

Your boat will take you through famous zones including:

- Sajnekhali Watchtower
- Mangrove Interpretation Centre
- Sarakkhali-1
- Sudhanyakhali
- Bonbibi Bharani
- Pirkhali
- Dobanki (Canopy Walk)
- Sunderkhali
- Panchmukhani

These waterways offer the best chances to spot wildlife such as crocodiles, spotted deer, water monitor lizards, monkeys, wild boars, numerous birds, and with some luck—the **Royal Bengal Tiger**.

A fresh lunch will be served on the boat. You'll also get a glimpse of the simple lifestyle and culture of the local villagers. Return to the resort in the evening for tea, snacks, and dinner at **9 PM**.

Day 3: Sundarbans → **Kolkata**

After breakfast, check out by **9:00 AM**. Visit **Gosaba** to explore the historic **Hamilton Bungalow** and **Rabindranath Tagore's Bungalow**.



Enjoy an early lunch on the boat before returning to Gadkhali Jetty. From here, drive back to Kolkata with unforgettable memories of forests, rivers, culture, and wildlife.

(Cancellation only through email)

- Within 10 days / No Show: 100% cancellation

Child Policy

- Below 4 years: **Free**
- 4 to under 8 years: 50% of adult price
- Above 8 years: **Full charge** (*Carry age proof for verification*)

Force Majeure Clause

If the tour is cancelled due to natural calamities, political unrest, or government restrictions, a **credit note** will be issued.

This can be used for any Sundarban tour within 6 months, subject to availability.

Do's & Don'ts in Sundarban

Do's

- Carry umbrella, sunglasses, hat, sunblock
- Wear light cotton clothes (green/ash/light-brown preferred)



- Use comfortable shoes/gumboots
- Carry regular medicines
- Drink only filtered/mineral/coconut water
- Keep a torch with extra batteries
- Bring binoculars and spare camera batteries
- Stay silent during wildlife sightings

Don'ts

- No loud music or speakers
- No entry into forest after sunset
- No hunting or fishing
- Do not pluck flowers
- Avoid bright or glossy clothes
- Do not disturb wildlife
- Alcohol strictly prohibited on boat & inside forest
- No plastic bottles, bags, or chip packets in core area
- Do not throw waste from the boat
