

# Ayodhya – Varanasi – Prayagraj Spiritual Tour



## Day 1: Howrah / Sealdah – Ayodhya (Overnight Train Journey)

Board the train from Howrah or Sealdah Railway Station for Ayodhya. Enjoy an overnight journey as you travel towards one of India's most sacred cities.

## Day 2: Arrival at Ayodhya – Local Sightseeing

Upon arrival at Ayodhya, meet our representative and transfer to the hotel for check-in and freshening up.

Later, proceed for a guided sightseeing tour of Ayodhya covering:

- **Shri Ram Janmabhoomi Temple** – Darshan at the grand temple built at the birthplace of Lord Shri Ram
- **Hanuman Garhi** – One of the most revered temples dedicated to Lord Hanuman
- **Kanak Bhawan** – Famous for its beautiful idols of Lord Ram and Goddess Sita
- **Dashrath Mahal** – The ancient palace of King Dashrath
- **Ram Ki Paidi** – Sacred ghats along the holy Sarayu River

In the evening, visit the banks of the **Sarayu River** to witness the soulful **Sarayu Aarti**, a truly divine and peaceful experience.

Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight stay in Ayodhya.

## Day 3: Ayodhya – Varanasi

After breakfast, transfer to Varanasi by road/train.

On arrival, check in to the hotel and relax.

The rest of the day is free for personal activities or leisure.

Overnight stay in Varanasi.

## **Day 4: Varanasi Local Sightseeing & Sarnath**

Early morning visit to the sacred **Kashi Vishwanath Temple** for darshan, followed by a serene **boat ride on the River Ganga** to witness sunrise and morning rituals at the ghats.

After breakfast, proceed for sightseeing including:

- **Banaras Hindu University (BHU)**
- **Tulsi Manas Mandir**
- **Durga Temple** (wherever vehicle access is permitted)

Later, visit **Sarnath**, the place where Lord Buddha delivered his first sermon. Explore:

- Dhamek Stupa
- Chaukhandi Stupa
- Mulagandha Kuti Vihar
- Sarnath Museum

Return to Varanasi in the evening.

Overnight stay in Varanasi.

## **Day 5: Varanasi – Prayagraj (Day Excursion)**

After an early breakfast, proceed for a full-day excursion to **Prayagraj** (approx. 120 km / 3 hours).

Sightseeing includes:

- **Triveni Sangam** – The holy confluence of Ganga, Yamuna, and Saraswati rivers
- **Hanuman Mandir**
- **Anand Bhavan**

Experience the spiritual aura of this historic city before returning to Varanasi by evening.

Overnight stay in Varanasi.

## **Day 6: Varanasi – Departure**

After breakfast, enjoy free time for a final visit to **Kashi Vishwanath Temple** or explore local markets famous for **Banarasi silk, handicrafts, and souvenirs**.

Later, transfer to Varanasi Railway Station to board the train for your onward journey.

## Day 7: Arrival at Howrah / Sealdah – Tour Ends

Arrive at Howrah / Sealdah / Kolkata with cherished spiritual memories.  
**Tour concludes.**

## Child Policy

## Booking Terms

- Minimum **30% advance** required to confirm seats
- **50% payment** within 15 days of confirmation
- **Full payment** 15 days prior to departure

## Cancellation Policy

- Minimum **30% retention** on any cancellation

- **50% charge** if cancelled before 30 days of departure
- **75% charge** if cancelled before 15 days of departure
- **100% charge** if cancelled within 10 days of departure (no refund)
- No refund for cancellations due to natural calamities, pandemics, political unrest, or transport disruptions
- Cancellation policy applies regardless of expenses incurred
- No cancellations during peak seasons or special occasions (Durga Puja, Diwali, Christmas, New Year, Holi, Republic Day, Independence Day, etc.)
