

Kinnaur Kalpa Tour – 10 Nights 11 Days



Day 1: Journey Begins – Howrah to Kalka

Your memorable Shimla–Sarahan–Sangla–Chitkul–Kalpa journey begins early in the morning at Howrah Station. As birds sing and the soft morning light welcomes the day, board the Kalka Mail at 7:40 AM.

Spend the entire day on the train, settling into the rhythm of the journey and enjoying the excitement of what lies ahead. Overnight stay on the train as you travel towards the mountains.

Day 2: Onboard Journey Continues

Wake up to another beautiful sunrise as the train moves steadily forward. Today is all about relaxation. Overnight stay on the Kalka Mail.

Day 3: Chandigarh – Shimla

Arrive at Chandigarh in the morning and experience the vibrant culture of Punjab. Meet your driver and begin the scenic drive to Shimla, the charming former summer capital of British India.

Visit Shimla Kalibari, stroll along the iconic Mall Road, and explore local stalls selling woollen handicrafts and souvenirs. Relish Shimla's famous food and desserts while enjoying the cool mountain breeze.

Dinner at the hotel and overnight stay in Shimla.

Day 4: Shimla – Kufri – Sarahan



Today, travel along the historic Hindustan–Tibet Road towards Sarahan, located at about 6,000 feet in the Sutlej Valley. Snow-capped peaks, yaks, and serene landscapes accompany you throughout the journey.

En route, visit Kufri, a favorite among photographers and adventure lovers. Explore its woollen markets offering high-quality shawls, sweaters, and caps.

Stop at Green Valley, known for its misty views, cedar forests, and breath-taking scenery at an altitude of 2,450 meters.

Enjoy lunch on the way, reach Sarahan by evening, and enjoy dinner at the hotel. Overnight stay in Sarahan.

Day 5: Sarahan – Sangla Valley

Begin your morning with fresh tea and head to the revered Bhimakali Temple, a major pilgrimage site surrounded by majestic Himalayan views.

Later, proceed towards Sangla Valley. Visit Kamru Village, the ancient capital of the Bashahr principality. Explore the historic Kamru Fort, believed to house 33 crore deities and dedicated to Devi Kamakhya.

Continue to Batseri Village, famous for its scenic beauty, traditional wooden houses, local handicrafts, Kinnauri caps, shawls, trout farms, and chilgoza nuts.

Visit the beautifully carved Badrinarayan Temple, rebuilt by villagers after a fire in 1998.

End the day at the Baspa River, where snow-clad mountains, flowing water, and traditional Kinnauri culture create perfect photo opportunities. Overnight stay in Sangla.

Day 6: Sangla – Chitkul – Sangla

After breakfast, head towards Chitkul, the last inhabited village near the Indo–China border. Known for having the cleanest air in India, Chitkul offers unmatched serenity, stunning landscapes, and peaceful village life.

Explore the village, enjoy its pleasant weather, and admire views of the Kinnaur Kailash range. Later, return to Sangla Valley, often called the “Pass of Light” due to its abundant sunshine and expansive natural beauty. Lunch en route or at the hotel.

Overnight stay in Sangla.

Day 7: Sangla – Kalpa

Travel to Kalpa, a beautiful village known for its temples, monasteries, and apple orchards. Enjoy breathtaking views of the Kinnaur Kailash range and the Sutlej River flowing far below. Visit the famous Suicide Point, offering dramatic views of deep valleys and vertical cliffs, along with apple orchards stretching across the hillsides.

Lunch on the way or at the hotel. Overnight stay in Kalpa.



Day 8: Kalpa – Reckong Peo – Roghi – Kalpa

Today, explore Reckong Peo, an all-season destination located at 2,290 meters. The fragrance of pine, apple, and deodar forests fills the air.

Admire the sacred Kinnaur Kailash, standing at 6,059 meters, with its natural rock formation resembling a Shivalinga.

Visit Hu-Bu-Lan-Kar Monastery, founded between 950–1055 AD, and experience its calm spiritual atmosphere.

Proceed to Roghi Village, perched on a steep mountain slope, offering jaw-dropping views of the Kinnaur Kailash range and thrilling cliff-side roads.

Lunch en route or at the hotel. Dinner and overnight stay in Kalpa.

Day 9: Kalpa – Chandigarh

After breakfast, begin your return journey towards Chandigarh. Enjoy lunch on the way.

Board the Kalka Mail at 1:10 AM from Chandigarh for your overnight train journey.

Day 10: Train Journey Back Home

Spend the day revisiting your photos and reliving unforgettable moments from the tour. Share a few snapshots with loved ones and let them experience your journey through your memories.

Overnight stay on the train.

Day 11: Arrival at Howrah – Tour Ends

Arrive at Howrah Station at 8:00 AM with a heart full of memories. This marks the end of your unforgettable Kinnaur–Kalpa–Sangla–Chitkul tour from Kolkata.
