



Leh–Ladakh Tour | 6 Nights / 7 Days



Leh Airport Pickup & Leh Airport Drop

Route:

Leh → Nubra Valley (via Khardung La Pass) → Turtuk → Pangong Lake (via Shayok) → Leh (via Chang La Pass)

Night Stay Plan:

Leh – 3 Nights | Nubra Valley – 2 Nights | Pangong Lake – 1 Night

Total: 6 Nights / 7 Days

Hotel Details

Day 01: Arrival at Leh – Hotel Transfer – Acclimatization Day

On arrival at Leh Airport, located at an altitude of approximately 3,500 meters (11,500 ft), our representative will receive you and assist with a smooth transfer to your hotel. Due to Leh's high altitude, this day is kept entirely for rest and acclimatization.

After check-in, enjoy a traditional welcome with tea or a welcome drink. The rest of the day is reserved for relaxation to help your body adjust to the thin mountain air. Guests are advised to avoid physical exertion, stay hydrated, and consume light meals.



In the evening, you may spend time at leisure—either relaxing at the hotel or taking a gentle walk around nearby market areas. You can browse local handicraft shops or enjoy authentic Ladakhi butter tea at a café. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel in Leh.

Day 02: Leh Local Sightseeing

After breakfast, proceed for a full day of local sightseeing in and around Leh. Begin with a visit to the peaceful Sindhu Ghat, followed by Shey Palace, once the royal residence of Ladakh's kings. Continue to the famous 3 Idiots School, a popular stop for movie lovers.

Later, visit the stunning Thiksey Monastery, often referred to as the “Mini Potala Palace,” known for its impressive architecture and spiritual ambiance. Proceed to Hemis Monastery, one of the largest and richest monasteries in Ladakh, renowned for its ancient relics and vibrant murals.

Return to the hotel for lunch. The afternoon is free for leisure—relax at the hotel or explore Leh Market for souvenirs and handicrafts. Enjoy dinner and overnight stay in Leh.

Day 03: Leh to Nubra Valley via Khardung La Pass

After breakfast, depart for Nubra Valley via the iconic Khardung La Pass, one of the world's highest motorable roads. The journey of approximately 120 km takes around 5–6 hours and offers breathtaking views of snow-covered peaks and dramatic mountain landscapes.

Stop at Khardung La Pass (5,300 meters / 17,582 ft) to capture memorable photographs at this legendary location. Descend into Nubra Valley, where the scenery transforms into lush greenery, rivers, and charming villages.

On arrival, check in to your hotel and enjoy lunch. Later, visit Diskit Monastery, home to the towering Maitreya Buddha statue overlooking the valley. Proceed to Hunder Sand Dunes, where you can see the rare double-humped Bactrian camels and enjoy a short camel ride (optional).

Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight stay in Nubra Valley.

Day 04: Excursion to Turtuk – Return to Diskit

After breakfast, head out for an excursion to Turtuk, one of India's northernmost villages, located near the Indo-Pak border. The drive of about 85 km takes around 4–5 hours through scenic valleys and rugged mountain terrain.

Turtuk, once part of Baltistan, offers a unique cultural experience with traditional Balti houses, apricot orchards, and warm local hospitality. Visit Thang Village, the last Indian village on this route, and experience a culture distinctly different from the rest of Ladakh.



Lunch can be taken at a local eatery at your own expense. By evening, return to Diskit. Relax at the hotel, enjoy dinner, and overnight stay in Nubra Valley.

Day 05: Nubra Valley to Pangong Lake via Shayok

After breakfast, check out and proceed towards Pangong Lake via the scenic Shayok route. The journey covers approximately 155 km and takes around 7–8 hours, running alongside the beautiful Shayok River.

This route offers a thrilling mix of landscapes, river crossings, and wide open valleys—perfect for photography and nature lovers. Short stops may be taken en route for refreshments.

By afternoon, arrive at the breathtaking Pangong Lake, famous for its ever-changing shades of blue. Check in to your lakeside cottage and enjoy tea while soaking in the serene surroundings. Spend the evening walking along the lake or simply enjoying the silence of nature. Dinner and overnight stay near Pangong Lake under a star-lit sky.

Day 06: Pangong Lake to Leh via Chang La Pass

After breakfast, begin your return journey to Leh via Chang La Pass, another high-altitude mountain pass. The distance of around 160 km takes approximately 5–6 hours.

Enjoy spectacular views of snow-clad mountains, winding roads, and pristine valleys throughout the drive. On arrival in Leh, check in to your hotel and relax.

The rest of the day is free for leisure or last-minute shopping at the local market. Dinner and overnight stay in Leh.

Day 07: Leh – Airport Drop

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and transfer to Leh Airport for your onward journey. As you leave this magical land of monasteries, mountains, and lakes, carry back unforgettable memories of Ladakh's beauty and spirit.

Tour ends with beautiful memories.
