


Shimla Manali Tour - 10 Nights 11 Days



Day 1: Howrah – Kalka / Chandigarh (By Train)

Your memorable Himachal journey begins as you board the train from Howrah for Kalka or Chandigarh. Overnight train journey.

Day 2: On Board the Train

Enjoy the day on the train, relaxing and gearing up for the scenic mountains ahead. Overnight journey continues.

Day 3: Arrival at Kalka / Chandigarh – Transfer to Shimla

On arrival at Kalka or Chandigarh, our representative will receive you and drive you to Shimla amidst beautiful hill views. After hotel check-in, the rest of the day is free for relaxation and acclimatization.

Overnight stay: Shimla

Day 4: Shimla Sightseeing – Kufri & Mall Road

After breakfast, proceed for a half-day excursion to **Kufri**, famous for its panoramic views and snow activities (seasonal). En-route visit **Green Valley** and **Jakhu Hills**.

In the evening, explore **Mall Road**, **Christ Church**, and local markets at leisure.

Overnight stay: Shimla

Day 5: Shimla – Naggar Castle – Bhuntar

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and drive towards Bhuntar. En-route visit the historic **Naggar Castle**, offering stunning views of the Kullu Valley. Continue the journey to Bhuntar and check in to the hotel.

Overnight stay: Bhuntar

Day 6: Bhuntar – Manikaran – Kullu – Manali

After breakfast, visit **Manikaran Sahib Gurudwara**, renowned for its holy hot springs. Later explore **Kullu** and proceed to Manali via picturesque mountain roads. Check in to the hotel on arrival.

Overnight stay: Manali

Day 7: Manali Local Sightseeing

After breakfast, enjoy local sightseeing in Manali covering **Hadimba Devi Temple, Vashisht Ashram & Hot Springs, Manu Temple, and Riverside Park**. Evening is free for shopping and café hopping at **Manali Mall Road**.

Overnight stay: Manali

Day 8: Solang Valley – Atal Tunnel – Sissu Excursion

Early morning departure to **Solang Valley**, a paradise for adventure lovers. Continue through the iconic **Atal Tunnel** to **Sissu Village**, known for its breathtaking landscapes. Later return to Manali by evening.

Overnight stay: Manali

Day 9: Manali – Chandigarh / Kalka Drop

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and transfer to **Chandigarh or Kalka Railway Station** for your onward train journey.

Day 10: On Board the Train

Enjoy the return journey by train.

Day 11: Arrival at Kolkata

Arrive at **Howrah / Sealdah Station** with beautiful memories of the Himachal tour. **Tour concludes.**

Child Policy

- Up to 5 years (1 child per family, without food): **Free**
- 6 to 9 years: **50% of adult cost**
- 9 to 11 years: **80% of adult cost**
- 12 years & above: **Full adult charge**

Booking Terms

- Minimum **30% advance** required to confirm seats
- **50% payment** to be completed within 15 days of confirmation
- **Full payment** must be made 15 days prior to departure

Cancellation Policy

- Minimum **30% retention** applicable on any cancellation
- 50% charge if cancelled **before 30 days** of departure
- 75% charge if cancelled **before 15 days** of departure
- **100% charge** if cancelled within **10 days** of departure (no refund)
- No refund in case of cancellation due to natural calamities, pandemics, political unrest, road or train disruptions
- Cancellation policy applies regardless of whether expenses have been incurred
- **No cancellations allowed during peak seasons or special occasions** such as Durga Puja, Christmas, New Year, Diwali, Holi, Independence Day, Republic Day, etc.
